Rules & Attire	Modified Colorado Sates High Schools Rules Athletics Association, as approved by the WSWL, with the Tournament Directors' discretion. Singlet's, headgear required, Shoelaces must be secured, hairnets and mouth guards by rule.
Time Periods	6 & 8 year olds – Three (60) sixty second periods. 10,12 & 14 year olds Three (90) Ninety seconds periods.
Bracketing	Mat Side Bracketing, up to 32 man Straight Line Brackets,100% Blind Draw, *Wrestle Backs , No Double Bracketing, Numbered matches, Brackets with three (3) or less wrestlers will be combined by the bracketing room staff with due consideration given to actual age and weight. NO wrestler will be moved more then one weight class or one age group without a coach and/or parents approval. No Changes will be made once wrestling begins. *Maximum of 6 matches will be wrestled, except if a wrestle back is necessary then a 7th match will be allowed.

Officials & Training	Certified High School Referees, Head Referee – Al Harrington. A Certified Trainer on duty for the duration of the tournament, the trainer will be housed in the training room located in the hallway in the two gyms.

The Tournament Director reserves the right to refuse the participation of any club, coach, wrestler and/or spectators. Only **TWO Bronze Certified** coaches will be allowed in any wrestler's corner. **No one will be allowed mat side without a Visible USA Bronze Card.**
